During the months of March and April of 2010, several members of the Rose Lake Pony Club field tested the garments you provided. The most frequently used garments were the vests and gloves.

Comments:

Lexi – I have never been able to ride in February in just a vest and felt warm before.
Jules – the vest is an excellent fit. The warmers make it wonderful to ride in the indoor when it is 10 outside. Still needed my gloves though. Even my feet were warm. Warm the core warm the body.
Lindsey – I like the fit. I like the ability to add warmers or take them out. Made it a great choice for riding in the indoor in the sub freezing temps we had all winter.
Sara – Warm, I was warm when I rode in the vest.
Choloe – (age 7) – while it was a little big, it still kept me warm.
Kealan – at games practices in March – I got too warm so I took out the warmers. After we were done, I put them back in.

In summary – the kids liked the vest a lot.

Gloves – I used a set and so did Jules. We previously suggest an engineering change to you, other than that the gloves worked great. I wore them on trail rides during the winter, and my fingers usually freeze. Not this year.

In summary – the products are great up here in the north. Had we had them in January and February you would have gotten more of the same results.
